
IMPLEMENTATION:

 In accordance with the Technical Description below and the drawings herewith.

- 2) Approved Riggers to perform modifications with materials supplied free of charge any payment of an amount of USD35.00 to cover direct labour cost.
- 3) Dealers to recall all affected canopies and advise manufacturer to serial numbers to allow for item (2) above and for record keeping purposes.

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION:

The integrity of the Parachute is increased through the introduction of an additional external Kevlar reinforcing skirt hand and through the placing of bartacks at the intersection of all main seams and reinforcing bands.

Thread - 'E' Thread or equivalent.
