- Supported by riggers and pilots sub-committees who tie in with latest equipment or aircraft regulatory impacts / safety notices that we need to know about and work with

Fifteen volunteer BPA members elected annually from the BPA membership who:

- Serve the membership via committee tasks to maintain strategic direction of the sport via action plans
- Co-ordinate with other National Governing Bodies such as the Royal Aero Club / FAI

- Comply with and maintain the Articles of Association

Communications committee

Council members who:

- Responsible for communicating with the membership and general public
- Support production of BPA publications such as *Skydive the Mag* and its website / *Starter Mag* / Facebook and Twitter
 - Manage communication strategy and funding
 - Responsible for the AGM event

Competitions committee

Council members who:

- Organise UK competition jumping events such as Grand Prix / Regional and National Championships
- Define selection criteria for National teams
- Define rules for UK events based on worldwide standards
- Develop competition scene with coaching-support events
- Manage competition strategy and funding
- Are supported by judging pool

Development committee

Council members who:

- Manage development strategy / direction
- Engage with the membership via surveys to support the direction and needs of the members
- Sourcing of other funding opportunities to members via grants etc
- Website / online development for new services such as online renewals and other interactive membership requirements
